Practice report

- Sarah discussed the last year from the view of the practice (See attached slides)
- Patient national survey carried out in July, overall very good, ranking has dropped slightly for overall experience of making an appointment from 3rd to 5th.
- Friends and Family test 94% of patients asked would recommend the practice, this is unchanged from last year.
- Premises update, the practice has finally received approval for the move. We are anticipating the move to take place late April with Haldens closing earlier than this. The Practice will close at its current locations on the Thursday and reopen at the new clinic on the Monday. All clinical and non clinical staff will be at the new location. "Only the building is changing not the Practice"
- Flu programme, we hit our target to ensure 75% of patients over 64 years are vaccinated.
- Cancer screening, Breast, Bowel and Cervical. Statistics were presented
- Extended Access which launched in March 2018.
- Weight Loss programmes are still running offering 12 weeks free help to qualifying patients.

Sarah gave thanks on behalf of the practice to the group for their work over the year.

Areas for 2019

- Move to the new building, PV have offered to be Patient Navigators in the new building to assist patients finding their way around.
- Communication.
- Promotion of Cancer screening along with the virtual group and FB.
- Park Run.
- Look into transport to the new building again now we have the go ahead.

Mark Edwards

Mark's team will be working with PV groups to help promote Cancer screening awareness. He will email newsletters to the group which can then be shared with the virtual group. Mark is interested in talking to patients with Respiratory conditions to sit on a patient panel to help shape services. **Action**: Any interested candidates to let Sarah or Natalie know who will pass details to Mark Edwards.
